ATTENTION PLEASE

Convener's Note:

It is indeed a privileged and a hard challenge to be volunteered at the Quarantine Centre especially in such a pandemic situation. When the positive case of this virus was first reported in India at Kerala, I was at Kochi. I can imagine how frightened I was of this fatal virus. After coming back home, I was outspokenly loud for extreme precautions and for the strict quarantine of the returnee. As the WSBK & WSH come together to shoulder the Government by running a Quarantine Centre at Livingstone Foundation International, I did not expect this responsibility of Convener to be anointed upon me. But yes, I am humbled to be ministering to the returnees with my little service. As a church leader, one of the things that really provoked my thought is, the returnees are all our brothers and sisters and members of our churches. They have been experiencing many derogatory remarks as corona, they have been stigmatized and discriminated by the mainland citizens. And if all of us stay home to stay free, who would come forward to help and comfort them. This thought has motivated and strengthened me to be on the frontline. As said, there are thousands returning and if we think or say that the Government should take all these responsibilities, it is not going to be possible. Therefore as Church we must all come forward to help the returnees in all possible ways.

We have 155 quarantine female individuals at our Centre with two infants. In collaboration with the Government, with all the best available facilities, we are doing our best to meet their needs. In the past we say, human wants are unlimited, but today it looks like, human needs are unlimited too. It is interesting to notice that there is one or the other new need arising every day and to meet the needs of 155 is not an easy job.

At this Centre, we are six volunteers; whose names were not even mentioned or entrusted by the committee to be at the frontline, but all willingly came forward to serve and bless others. We have left our families and small children, and have volunteered to be away from home for 14 days which is another aspect of a challenge.

We are so grateful to the authority of Livingstone Foundation International for allowing us to use this beautiful campus. The services of Thahekhu Village are highly commendable, both in man power and material or financial contributions.

With the able leadership and supports of Rev. Dr. Phughoto Sema, Executive Secy. WSBK and Dr. Kakheto Zhimomi President -WSH, The WSBK & WSH has been unceasingly working for the betterment of the quarantine centre and helps are coming from different sections in cash and kind for the smooth functioning of this Centre. We are looking forward to have more good updates every day. Taking this opportunity we would also like to give our heartfelt gratitude to all the working committee conveners and members for your active support and participations, we also give thanks for all the ongoing supports which we have received from the Govt., the Churches, well wishers, the medical team, the sanitation and waste management team.

As the whole world is gripped with novel Coronavirus, the number of active cases have been increasing every day. The Government of India as well as the state government of Nagaland is also trying to put up its best efforts in containing the COVID-19. In this fight against Coronavirus, the Western Sümi Hoho (WSH) and Western Sümi Baptist Akukuhou Küqhakulu (WSBAK) have joint hands to manage a Quarantine Centre at Livingstone Foundation International, Kevijäü/ Thahekhu, Dimapur Nagaland.

As on May 27, 2020 there are 155 females being quarantined in the centre from 3 districts. The Centre has the capacity to host 200 at a time and it is open to any citizen of Nagaland.

The Centre is being run by the generous contributions from members of WSH and WSBAK and well wishers.

Facilities provided at the centre:

Items prepared for each quarantined individuals:

1. Bed
2. Bedspread
3. Pillow and cover




We pray to you, God of mercy,

May you lead us to combat racism, discrimination, stigmatization and xenophobia with courage in the midst of this health crisis.


We pray to you, God of love,

Amen.


